

Care Kit for the Homeless Service Project

Objective:

This In-House Service Project is a great way to help support local homeless shelters and the members of the community that may need extra support. These kits can support the recipients by providing them useful objects as an alternative to monetary donations.

Materials:

- Gallon size zip-lock bag
- Socks
- Snacks and water
- Hygiene items
- Resource guide (optional)
- Seasonal items: Summer- sunblock Winter- gloves and hand warmers

Steps:

1. Collect all the materials
2. Split up materials
3. Create an assembly line with people at each object you're putting in the care kit
4. Start filling the care kit bags
5. Optional: Include information about local shelters and community resources that can help those without a home
6. Collect bags
7. Distribute care kits by either donating them to a homeless shelter or distributing them on your own
8. Talk to the recipients if you would like, often a conversation is most meaningful to them
